



Terms:

- Payment for tuition is due in advance. Invoices are sent by email for the full term's activities before the start of each term. Tuition may not be given where payment has not been made.
- If a student misses an individual lesson, the fee for that lesson will still be charged unless at least 24 hours advanced notice of absence has been given to the teacher. A cancelled lesson due to teacher absence will either be credited to the following term or re-arranged for later in the term.
- If a student misses an ensemble or class session, the fee for that session will still be charged. A cancelled session due to teacher absence will either be credited to the following term or re-arranged for later in the term.
- To cancel a lesson, students should make direct contact with the instrumental / vocal teacher.
- Payment by bank transfer or via Stripe link is preferred.
- A one-off registration fee of £15 is added to the first invoice for each new student or family on joining Harrogate Music School before tuition commences.
- Neither Harrogate Music School nor Harrogate Grammar School can be held responsible for any accident, theft or damage that may occur on the teaching premises.
- For safe-guarding reasons, no adults are allowed within the Harrogate Grammar School buildings before 5:00pm under any circumstances.
- To cancel tuition, four lessons notice in writing to both the teacher and the director of Harrogate Music School is required.
- All discounts are given at the discretion of Harrogate Music School.
- No reimbursement can be made for ensemble or class activities.
- All fees are reviewed on an annual basis.
